Company / Function

The team also provides hands-on support for installation, testing and commissioning of new equipment, both internally and at our customers' sites, all over the world.

Job Purpose

We are seeking a motivated and experienced Dispatch and Packing Team Supervisor to join our team. The ideal candidate will have a strong background in Packing and Logistics, of large goods within an engineering or manufacturing environment. The selected candidate will be responsible for managing a team, optimizing workflows, and ensuring that all goods are packed securely and shipped according to schedule, while maintaining the highest standards of safety and compliance.

Key Responsibilities

- 1. Lead, train, and motivate a team of dispatch and packing staff.
- 2. Foster a collaborative, safety-conscious environment, promoting teamwork and effective communication.
- 3. Ensure all activities are carried out in full compliance with company health and safety policies and relevant regulations.
- 4. Oversee and coordinate daily dispatch and packing activities, managing competing requirements, ensuring orders are processed and shipped on time.
- 5. Collaborate with Project Managers and Production team to ensure accurate and timely preparation of finished goods for dispatch.
- 6. Manage packaging materials and inventory to avoid shortages or overstocking in line with demand.
- 7. Liaise with freight suppliers and shipping agents to secure appropriate delivery routes in line with governance and customer requirements.
- 8. Utilise knowledge of appropriate packing materials and techniques to ensure goods are packaged securely, safely, and efficiently.
- 9. Ensure all outgoing goods are thoroughly inspected for quality and accuracy before dispatch.
- 10. Ensure correct labelling, documentation, and tracking information is completed for all shipments.



- 11. Identify inefficiencies in processes and proactively recommend improvements for greater efficiency and cost savings.
- 12. Other related duties as assigned.

Skills/Experience

- Previous experience in a leadership or supervisory role within a dispatch, packing, or logistics function, ideally within a heavy engineering or manufacturing environment.
- Excellent organisational skills, with the ability to prioritize tasks and manage competing demands from various stakeholders.
- Proven ability to work with various packing techniques, materials, and machinery to safely pack heavy and complex items.
- Strong communication skills and the ability to lead and develop a team.
- Attention to detail with a focus on Health and Safety.
- Proficiency in Microsoft Office and familiarity with inventory management or dispatch software is desirable.
- Experience and clear understanding of shipping and dispatch processes.
- Experience in a heavy engineering or manufacturing environment.
- Forklift certification or other relevant warehouse / shipping qualifications.
- Knowledge of lean manufacturing principles or continuous improvement methodologies
